Bill and Evelyn Bullington – Bill and Evelyn currently serves with the Arkansas Baptist Convention. Prior to serving in our convention they served as missionaries in West Africa for more than 30 years.

Disaster Relief Team – In recent years, the Disaster Relief Team from the Arkansas Baptist Convention has been in the news for helping in times of crisis. There are many ways a person can be involved in ministering to those in need.

Hal and Esther Garrett – Hal and Esther are consultants to Arkansas employed by the North American Mission Board of the Southern Baptist Convention. They reside in Northeast Arkansas but travel throughout the state encouraging churches to be involved in state and local missions.
